



Tour to Dashbashi Canyon



Experience one of Georgia's most spectacular natural wonders on a full-day tour to **Dashbashi Canyon**, a dramatic gorge carved by volcanic rock and flowing waterfalls just two hours from Tbilisi. Located near the town of Tsalka, Dashbashi Canyon is a true hidden gem — home to lush greenery, hanging moss-covered cliffs, and a breathtaking 240-meter-long glass bridge, suspended high above the canyon floor. The bridge features a transparent walkway and a heart-shaped glass platform, making it one of the most

For thrill-seekers, optional activities like the **glass zipline bike** and **cliff swing** offer unforgettable views and a dose of adrenaline (activities for an extra cost)

After exploring the canyon trails, admire the impressive multi-level waterfalls, enjoy a relaxing walk through the gorge, or grab a coffee or lunch at the modern canyon viewpoint cafe.

Transfer back to Tbilisi

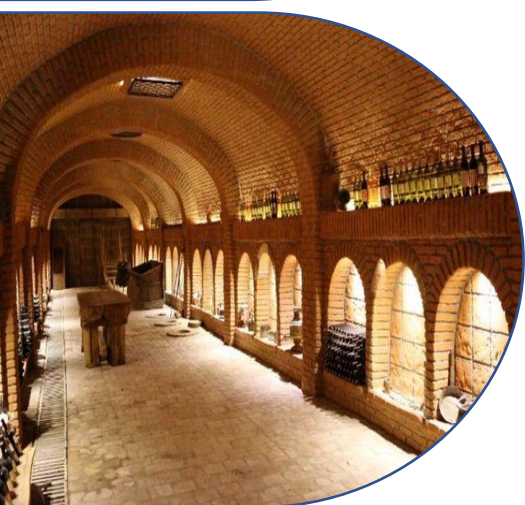

Kakheti Cultural & Wine Heritage Tour



Step into the heart of Georgia's legendary wine country with this immersive day tour through **Kakheti**, a region where **ancient monasteries, noble estates, and underground wine tunnels** tell the story of 8,000 years of winemaking tradition.

Valley as you head to **Alaverdi Monastery** — one of Georgia's oldest spiritual centers, founded in the 6th century.

In the afternoon, the experience reaches its flavorful peak at **Khareba Winery** – famous for its **wine tunnel carved into the rock** of the Caucasus Mountains.

Guests will participate in **Georgian culinary masterclasses**

Take a guided tour through the underground cellars, taste several varieties of Kakhetian wine, and learn about traditional qvevri winemaking.

After a short drive, arrive at the **Tsinandali Estate**, once the home of Georgian nobleman and poet Alexander Chavchavadze. Tour the elegant house-museum and stroll through its 19th-century landscaped garden. You'll also taste wine from one of Georgia's oldest bottled wine collections.

Tour to Kakheti

Bodbe Monastery, one of Georgia's holiest sites and the final resting place of Saint Nino. Surrounded by cypress trees and perched above the Alazani Valley, Bodbe offers stunning views and peaceful atmosphere.

Next, discover the romantic hilltop town of **Signaghi**, known as the "City of Love." Walk along its ancient fortress walls, enjoy panoramic views of the Caucasus Mountains, and explore its charming streets filled with art, history, and wine.

Continue your adventure with a visit to a **family-owned winery**, where you'll learn about Georgia's 8,000-year-old winemaking tradition using clay vessels called *qvevri*.

Kazbegi Tour

Old Tbilisi City Tour



- **Start Point: Metekhi Church**

Begin your day at the iconic **Metekhi Church of the Assumption**, perched on a cliff overlooking the Mtkvari River. Admire panoramic views and the equestrian statue of King Vakhtang Gorgasali, the city's legendary founder.

- Stroll down cobble streets to the **Sulfur Baths district**. Admire the unique domed bathhouse architecture.

- **Leghvtakhevi Waterfall** - Just a short walk from the baths, this hidden gem is a peaceful surprise in the heart of the city.

- **Narikala Fortress via Cable Car**

Ride the cable car from Rike Park to the top of Narikala Fortress. Take in sweeping views of the city, then explore the ancient ruins and the Mother of Georgia (**Kartlis Deda**) statue nearby.

- **Colorful Balconies & Old Town Houses** – Enjoy postcard views of traditional Georgian architecture hugging the cliffs and riverbanks.

- **Stroll Along Shardeni Street**

This lively pedestrian street is full of art galleries, cafes, wine bars, and local boutiques. Perfect for a relaxed walk or a coffee break.

- **Bridge of Peace & Rike Park**

Walk across this contemporary glass bridge that connects old and new Tbilisi.

- Boat tour on river **Mtkvari** - a boat ride offers a relaxing and scenic way to discover the capital's blend of ancient charm and modern elegance.

- Visiting **Radio Café** – where guests will have : **wine casino**, experience a modern gastronomic interpretation of the traditional Georgian khachapuri and taste Georgian Liqueurs by **Mary Jos**
